Lakeland Warehouse Facility Sells For \$3 Million

A company that manufactures automated poultry equipment will occupy an industrial warehouse at 2655 Old Tampa Highway in Lakeland, according to Steinbauer Associates, the Lakeland company that handled the deal. The 72,000-square-foot office and warehouse space sits on 12 acres and sold for \$3 million to DBM Associates. The occupant of the facility will be Alaso Inc., which makes equipment for poultry including layer cages, drinking systems and silos, according to [alaso.com](#). The deal closed last week. Jim Steinbauer, vice president of Steinbauer Associates, said that with the new facility Alaso is doubling the space it currently occupies at 2725 Mine Mill Road in Lakeland.
